Dear Parents/Guardians,

I want to update you on the current status of Pacific Union School District in connection with the coronavirus pandemic. The number one concern is the safety and welfare of our students, staff, and community. At this time, the County of Fresno feels it would be unsafe for our students to be served on a school campus. Unfortunately, students will not return for the remainder of this school year. Tentatively, the 2020-2021 school year will begin on Thursday, August 20, 2020.

On Tuesday, May 26th, a **summer educational packet and instructional plan** will be delivered, via the **morning bus route**, directly to your home. Each student will be given a **fourth packet** for the summer, of instructional materials and directions, created by their homeroom teacher. **You may return this packet when school starts in the fall.**

We will follow the **morning pick up bus routes at a delay of three hours BEGINNING** at 9:30 a.m. **Please watch for the bus as times will vary from the regular schedule.**

We will pick up **completed work packet(s)** at the same time as the summer work packet is dropped off. It is important that all **completed work in packets are returned as this may affect your child's final report card grades.** Library books and school sports uniforms may also be returned at this time.

If you missed your drop off or your child(ren) are not on the morning bus route, you may drop off completed work packets and pick up summer packets on Wednesday morning, May 27th from 9:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. in front of the school. Preschool and kindergarten registration packets may be picked up and /or completed registration packets may be dropped off. This will be a drive through process, **please do not get out of your car as packets will be collected and dispersed as you drive up in your car.**

If your child left any personal items (jacket, backpack, lunch box, etc.) at school, those items may be picked up **Tuesday, June 2nd and Wednesday, June 3rd** in front of the school between 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. This will be a drive through process only, do not get out of your car.

Again we appreciate everyone's support and cooperation as we work together during this challenging time.
